RDA Roberta Flecto: Swimming pool is exempt activity to be going where a garden was. Area is flat. In riverfront, but exempt by 3:10. Neg. 2. Clare made a motion for negative determination. Eric 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor.

Cease and desist 108 Sandisfield Rd- material was thrown in the wetlands. Owner was sent a letter last year. Committee asked to make a site visit. Site visit scheduled. Clare made motion to approve enforcement order. Mary  $2^{nd}$ . All in favor.

Cemetery Committee:Committee want to remove trees and stump from New Boston and Center Cemetery. 3 trees by streams and headstones. Given permission to mow . If stumped, will need an NOI. New Boston cemetery might need an engineer for NOI for erosion control. Municipalities do not pay fees for filling in sites. Group might want to consider Round-up which is approved in wetlands. At Center Cemetery, committee wantsto remove white birch that are 4-6 inches and leaning. Paul reminded group about the importance of the golden rod and milkweed. Also, that the generic NOI for the town is expired. Paul went over wetland regulations.
