Barbara Cormier complained that there is an overuse of the road superintendent doing odd jobs like changing light bulbs. She complained that the grading is not getting done. The Selectmen are addressing this. The highway department is now a DPW (Department of Public Works) and odd jobs are to be done by them. Brian explained that we have 2 graders operating at this time. It takes 52 sunny dry days to get the grading done with one grader. Brian reviewed the list of roads to be graded, they will all be done very soon.

Ron Pachulski asked about the Public Safety Officer add. He is curious as to whether the resumes will get to the Selectmen since they are the hiring authority. The selectmen responded that it was agreed upon that a copy of all resumes will be sent to them.
