Motion by Brian, second by Mark to award the electrical work to D. E. Wilber for \$8,562.23.

Public Safety Officer (PSO) Mike Johnson in to present a grant for Safe Grants to work with the seniors for 1,500. It is a non matching grant. It can be used for CO2 detectors or training classes. Nina Carr was very pleased with Mike's presentation to the Council on Aging regarding this grant. Grant reviewed and signed by the Selectmen.

Jeff Bye from the Broadband Committee in to discuss the Contribution and Assessment Agreement for the Town's obligation to repay the Commonwealth for the Town's share of the grant award to Charter in the amount of \$826,680.

There are three options, 10, 15, and 20 year payback plans. We will table this until the Selectmen have the chance to meet with the Town Accountant and the Town Treasurer to discuss alternative funding options. All selectmen agree on a 15 year payback.

Discussed the bulky waste collection for October. We will have 2 boxes available for Oct. 16, 19, 20, 23, 26 and 27.

Brian thanked Keith Larson for working on the Route 57 bridge for the past 9 days to complete the painting job. The bridge is now 100% painted.
