Mark asked about a time provision between the town and the Fire Dept., Inc. or is there an option for the town since we are leasing and don't own. Mike Morrison clarified that it is in place until it is replaced with a newer vehicle.

Roger Brown asked if there is an increase in the Fire Dept. budget. Brian responded it is the same as a lease we currently have on another fire truck. It will only cost \$1.00. The cost burden was on the Fire Dept., Inc. The town will insure and register it. This process was approved by Town Counsel.

Fire Chief Ralph Morrison is requesting permission to purchase a trailer for their 3 ATV's. Currently they have to use their personal trailers to move this equipment.

George asked about how many times they have used this equipment in the past couple years. Ralph responded that they average 1-2 times a year.

Mark stated that the DPW has a trailer that they can't use, maybe it would work. Mike responded that he has seen it and thinks it would work fine. Ralph and Mike will contact the DPW to review the trailer.
