MINUTES OF MEETING

PRESENT: Paul Gaudette, Mary Turek, Steve Harasyko, and Clare English

Paul opened the meeting at 7:00 P.M. Bills were paid and the mail perused.

Paul opened the public hearing for Smigel (204/51) at 7:15 P.M. on his RDA. A short discussion ensued regarding the cutting of trees. Clare made a motion to grant a negative determination. Seconded by Mary Turek, the motion carried unanimously. Paul closed the hearing at 7:25 P.M.

Paul opened the public hearing for the Town of Sandisfield (411/8) at 7:30 P.M. on their NOI. Robert O'Brien and Fred Ventresco were present to represent the town. The DEP had issued a file number but noted that certain obligations for an NOI had not been followed and they needed to be done before the commission could give a ruling. The NOI did not include an in depth description of the work to be done, no notice had been sent by certified mail to the abutters. DEP also felt the Army Corps of Engineers should be notified. Bobby said he talked to the Army Corps of Engineers and they were fine with the project. He was meeting with someone the next day. When all requirements were met the commission would then be able to give a ruling. Until then no work could be done on the project. The abutter's notice needed to be sent to the commission within the next week and also the DEP. The hearing was adjourned until September 18, 2018 at 7; 30 p.m.

Paul opened the public hearing for Croiber/Levine (204/58) at 7:35 P.M. on a RDA to expand deck. A short discussion ensued. Clare made a motion to grant a negative determination. Seconded by Paul, the motion carried unanimously. Paul closed the hearing at 7:45 P.M.

Paul opened the public hearing for Peter Brittingham (412/37) on his RDA for clearing trees at 7:50P.M. A short discussion followed. Mary Turek

Made a motion to grant a negative determination. Seconded by Steve Harasyko, the motion carried unanimously. Paul closed the hearing at 8:00 P.M.
