Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding anychapter 32 of the General Laws or section 2 of chapter

415 of the acts of 1987 or any other general or special law to the contrary, Town employees of

the town of Sandisfield who would be subject to mandatory retirement on the last day of the

4 month in which they turn 65 years old-pursuant to Chapter 415 of the Acts of 1987, may serve in

5 such position until the age of 70, or until the date of retirement or non-reappointment, whichever

6 occurs first; provided, however, that no deductions from regular compensation shall be made

7 under <u>said</u> chapter 32 of the General Laws subsequent to reaching the age of 65 in connection

with service to the Town forand upon retirement or pension purposes; and the employee shall

receive a superannuation retirement allowance equal to the allowance that the employee would

10 <u>have been entitled to had the employee retired upon reaching age 65</u>; provided, further, that the

employee is mentally and physically capable of performing the duties of the office. The town of

12 Sandisfield may, at the employee's own expense, require that the employeesemployee be

examined by an impartial physician designated by them to determine such capability.

SECTION 2. This Actact shall take effect upon its passage.
