

An Act authorizing the town of Sandisfield to continue the employment of employees subject to mandatory retirement.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 \_\_\_\_\_ SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ~~any chapter 32 of the General Laws or section 2 of chapter~~  
2 ~~415 of the acts of 1987 or any other~~ general or special law to the contrary, ~~Town~~ employees of  
3 ~~the town of Sandisfield~~ who would be subject to mandatory retirement on the last day of the  
4 month in which they turn 65 years old ~~pursuant to Chapter 415 of the Acts of 1987~~, may serve in  
5 such position until the age of 70, or until the date of retirement or non-reappointment, whichever  
6 occurs first; provided, however, that no deductions from regular compensation shall be made  
7 under said chapter 32 ~~of the General Laws~~ subsequent to reaching the age of 65 ~~in connection~~  
8 ~~with service to the Town for and upon retirement or pension purposes; and the employee shall~~  
9 ~~receive a superannuation retirement allowance equal to the allowance that the employee would~~  
10 ~~have been entitled to had the employee retired upon reaching age 65;~~ provided, further, that the  
11 employee is mentally and physically capable of performing the duties of the office. The town of  
12 Sandisfield may, at the employee's own expense, require that the ~~employees~~ employee be  
13 examined by an impartial physician designated by them to determine such capability.
