

RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
Monday, February 25, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Moderator Simon Winchester with the Pledge Allegiance and in memory of the Mohican Indian Tribe, the pathfinders of our community. There were 17 registered voters present. Meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m. Following are the results.

Article 1. The Town voted unanimously to appropriate \$4,706.92 for a Fiscal Year 2018 Legal Services Bill and to meet that appropriation transfer \$4,706.92 from Free Cash to Legal Services.
Select Board Vote: Unanimous
Finance Committee Vote: Unanimous

Article 2. The Town voted unanimously to appropriate \$8,000 for Legal Services for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2019 and to meet that appropriation transfer \$8,000 or from Free Cash to Legal Services.
Select Board Vote: Unanimous
Finance Committee Vote: Unanimous

Article 3. The Town voted unanimously to appropriate \$6,000 for the ALSS Intercept Service and to meet that appropriation transfer \$6,000 from Free Cash to ALSS Intercept Services.

Finance Committee Vote: Unanimous

Article 4. The Town voted by majority to adopt the following General Bylaw under Chapter VIII Miscellaneous Provision, Section 14 Fines and Penalties.

Non-Criminal Disposition

- Scope and Authority

This Bylaw provides for a non-criminal disposition of a violation of any Town Bylaw, the violation of which is subject to a specific penalty. This Bylaw is enacted in accordance with MGL c.40 §21D.

- Enforcing Person

“Enforcing Person,” as used in this Bylaw, shall mean any Police Officer of the Town of Sandisfield with respect to any offence; the Fire Chief and his/her designee; the Building Inspector and his/her designee; the Public Health Director and his/her designee; the Director of Public Works and his/her designee; the Dog Officer and his/her designee and such other officials as the Board of Selectmen or Bylaw may from time to time designate, each with respect to violations of the Bylaws within their respective jurisdictions. If more than one official has jurisdiction in a given case, any such official may be an enforcing person with respect thereto.

- Fines

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Section, when enforced pursuant to non-criminal disposition procedures of MGL c.40 §21D, the following shall be the fines applicable to the listed offenses, unless otherwise specifically provided by Bylaw.

First Violation: \$100

Second Violation: \$200


Third and Subsequent Violations: \$300

Each day a violation exists shall constitute a separate violation.
