which revolving funds together shall not exceed the sum of twenty-nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$29,500), which shall be under the control of the Town Treasurer, which shall be accounted for separately and to which shall be credited only the departmental receipts received in connection with the programs supported by each revolving fund; further to authorize the Town treasurer to expend from such funds in accordance with Chapter 44 Section 53 E1/2 of the Federal Laws, provided however,

that said expenditures for all revolving funds shall not exceed the receipts for such funds, or to take any other action relative thereto.
