To the Constables of the Town of Sandisfield


Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify all the inhabitants of the Town of Sandisfield, qualified to vote in the town affairs to meet at the Old Town Hall, 3 Silverbrook Rd., Sandisfield, MA at 7:00pm.

Article 1: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$9,500 or any other sum, for Machinery Maintenance, and to meet that appropriation transfer \$9,500 or any other sum from Free Cash.

Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$800 or any other sum, for Conservation Consultation Fees, and to meet that appropriation transfer \$800 or any other sum from Free Cash.
