Bid Instruction and Bid Form Package

The Town of Sandisfield, Massachusetts, is offering for sale the following items utilizing the sealed bid process.

Highway Department:

- 1968 Case Tractor.
- 1976 Chevrolet Ambulance.

Police and Fire Department equipment:

- 2004 Ford Expedition.
- 1977 OshKosh 2.5 truck with plow.
- 1980 GMC General Tanker.
- 1972 Z-Dodge W-30 power wagon.
- 1984 Kaiser 2.5-ton army truck.

All items can be viewed at the Sandisfield Highway Garage, 3 Silverbrook Road, Sandisfield, Massachusetts. To schedule a time when someone is present, contact Bob O'Brien at 413-717-7627.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, utilizing the Bid Form below, and with the outside of the envelope clearly inscribed with "Surplus Property Bid 2017#1," AND with words identifying the item(s) being bid on, using the descriptions presented above.

Each item must be bid on with a singular price for that item only; **one price for multiple items is not allowed.** Multiple bids may be in one envelope, but the outside of the sealed envelope must list clearly all the Individual items being bid on inside.

Bids must be received at the Sandisfield Town Office, Attn: Fred Ventresco, CPO/Town Administrator, 66 Sandisfield Road, Sandisfield, MA 01255, no later **than Monday, November 27, 2017, at 12:00 noon/PM**, at which time the bids will be opened in public and read. Bid award decisions will be announced at a later time.

Bids will be awarded to the responsive bidder offering the highest offer price for the item. In the event of a tie in the highest offer price, the Town may, at its discretion, decide to award the bid based on the flip of a coin between two tied bidders, or ask the tied bidders to re-submit a sealed bid, for no less than the amount of the tied highest offer. The Town also reserves the right to reject any and all bids

and to sell/dispose of the items through a negotiated sale, provided that the negotiated sale price is higher than the highest bid received from a responsive bidder.

Payment is due within one week of the award. Items not claimed and paid for within this timeframe will void the award and release the Town to dispose of the item to another party or otherwise as it sees fit. Payment must be by certified check, money order, or cash.

All items are sold “as is, where is” and carry absolutely no warranties, implied or explicit, whatsoever, nor are any certainties expressed as to the current condition or functionality of the item. It is the responsibility of the buyer to remove the item once paid for from Town premises in a legal manner.

The Town reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, to waive any minor irregularities and/or informalities as it deems to be in the best interest of the Town.
